The Namaske Lake Association was formed in July of 2008 by lake side residents to coordinate the process of eradication and suppression of future growth of the milfoil that has infested Namske Lake (formerly known as The Piscataquog River) in Goffstown and Manchester, NH since the Mothers Day Flood of 2006.

### **Who should join?**

Anyone interested in having a milfoil free lake for the summer of 2009 and beyond.

- **The goal is to treat the lake with an herbicide in the Spring of 2009,**

#### **Association Action Items:**

- The Association is submitting a grant request (for half of the funds) to the State of NH by 9/15/08
- Amy Smagula from DES will be re-mapping the infestation August of 2008
- Bids from State Approved contractors will be solicited by the Association before the DES deadline of October 15th. We expect the cost to be between \$60,000 - \$100,000.
- We will hear from the State reference the grant request by 11/30/08.
- We will then need to secure the remaining funds from the Town of Goffstown, and/or the City of Manchester, or other organizations.
- The contractor will apply for a license in January of 2009.
- Affected residents will be notified of the treatment and the time line once the license is granted, expected to be April 2009.
- Affected residents will again be notified of the treatment, and water restrictions just before the treatment takes place, expected to be in May of 2009.

### **What YOU can do to help:**

This association is dedicated solely to the Milfoil issue in Namaske Lake.
