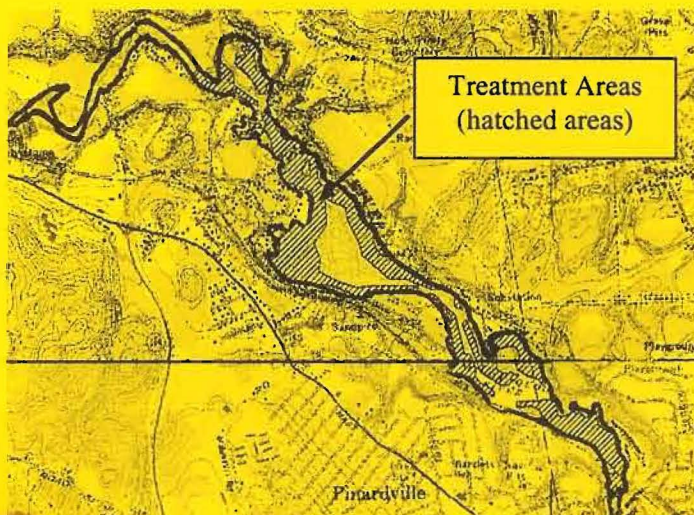


PORTIONS OF NAMASKE LAKE / PISCATAQUOG RIVER TO

# WARNING

The following temporary water use  
restrictions will be in effect after  
treatment for posted areas only:

- No swimming for 24 hours  
OR until 6/24 after 5 p.m.
- Do not use this water for drinking, irrigation or for mixing sprays for agricultural or ornamental plants until further notice. Some irrigation restrictions may be relaxed, as per the pesticide label, at the discretion of the applicator. These restrictions apply to all intakes within 1,200 feet of the treatment area, and to all wells within 50 feet of the treatment area. Any such applications would be in violation of the Administrative Rules of the Pesticide Control Board, and may result in substantial penalty.
